

An easier, faster way to pay initial premiums

Businesses are always looking for ways to save time. That's where our Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) service steps in.

EFT lets new plan sponsors make their first premium payment electronically, rather than using checks or cash. Money is sent directly from one bank to another. Now that's what we call convenience!

Why choose EFT?

It's simple. EFT is a fast, effective approach. Plan sponsors don't have to worry about sending checks with a case submission. After we notify them of plan approval, payment will be deducted directly from the plan sponsor's checking account. It only takes about one or two business days.

Getting started is as simple as 1, 2, 3 ...

1. To choose EFT, plan sponsors just need to complete a short form from our Underwriting team. It requests their bank routing and account number.
2. We only draft the account for the initial payment. Any following payments should be mailed to the address on the Aetna invoice.
3. We deduct the payment within one to two business days after receiving the signed rate page.

Now new Aetna enrollees can use EFT to pay their first premium. It's one less thing for them to worry about.
